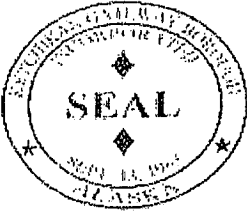

**\$5,500,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION
 BONDS - SCHOOL DISTRICT CAPITAL
 IMPROVEMENTS**

Shall Ketchikan Gateway Borough incur debt and issue general obligation bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$5,500,000, maturing within a maximum of 15 years, to pay costs of the capital improvements described in Ordinance No. 1634, including improvements and upgrades in Ketchikan High School, Revilla Junior/Senior High School, Schoenbar Middle School, Houghtaling Elementary School, Fawn Mountain Elementary School, and Point Higgins Elementary School, District-wide capital maintenance projects and other capital improvements, and shall Ordinance No. 1634 of the Borough authorizing the issuance of the bonds for these purposes be approved?
