

SAMPLE BALLOT

INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER: To vote for the issue/candidate of your choice, **fill in the oval next to the issue/candidate you want to vote for.** Place your ballot inside the secrecy sleeve and then take your ballot to the ballot box.

If you make a mistake while voting, return the ballot to the election official for a new one.
A vote which has been erased or changed will not be counted.

To vote for a person whose name is not printed on the ballot, fill in the oval and print the person's name on the blank line provided for a write-in candidate.

Should August 25 be a Saturday or a Sunday, then candidates shall have until noon on the first Monday following to file their petition. <u>Notwithstanding any other provision in this charter, no person shall be eligible to serve more than three (3) terms consecutively as a councilmember or more than three (3) terms consecutively as mayor. Election to serve the unexpired portion of a term shall be considered a full term for purposes of such limitations, however, the period served after appointment to a vacancy prior to an election to fill such vacancy shall not be considered a term for purposes of the limitations provided in this section.</u> If an office is to be filled for an unexpired term at a special election, nominating petitions shall be provided by the city clerk not later than 60 days prior to the special election and must be filed not later than 30 days before the special election. The petition may have been circulated and filed by the candidate or by one or more qualified voters other than the candidate.</p> <p>Should Ordinance No. 22-1948 which amends Section 10-3 "Filing" of Article X "Elections" of the City Charter so that no person shall be eligible to serve more than three (3) terms consecutively as councilmember or more than three (3) terms consecutively as mayor be enacted?</p> <p>A "Yes" vote ratifies Ordinance No. 22-1948, which would enact term limits for councilmembers and the mayor.</p> <p>A "No" vote rejects Ordinance No. 22-1948, which would not enact term limits for councilmembers and the mayor.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> Yes</p> <p><input type="radio"/> No</p>
