HAND COUNT INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Separate the ballots into piles of 25 ballots.
- 2. One person shall read the ballots and two board members shall tally. There is an original tally sheet and a duplicate tally sheet for that purpose.
- 3. A tick mark is made for each candidate counted. When the tick marks total five for one of the candidates the tally workers shall say "Tally". This assures that both tally workers are in sync with each other.
- 4. When each batch of twenty-five ballots is read the tally workers will change pens so the ink colors are different than the pens previously used. There are blue pens and red pens provided for this purpose. This allows a minimum of re-counting if the tally workers do not agree during the counting process.
- 5. A running total shall be maintained at the end of each row for each candidate.
- 6. When the counting is completed and both tally workers agree the tally sheets shall be signed by the Canvass Board members.
