SUMMARY STATEMENT

In its' efforts to complete a viable Consolidation Petition for submittal to the Local Boundary Commission by September 30, 2004, the Ketchikan Charter Commission adopted as a working draft the City of Ketchikan's 2001 Charter. Similarly, the Commission intends to review and modify the City of Ketchikan's 2001 Consolidation Petition and Exhibits.

During this weeks' meeting, the Commission recessed into work session and reviewed the Draft Petition, including the Draft Charter. Correspondence received from individuals was also discussed. Once the changes in this initial review are approved, the sections will revert to a working Draft document that will only be finalized at the time of submittal to the LBC.

Should no specific changes be suggested during the meeting's work session, this agenda item will be automatically postponed until the next meeting of the Commission.
